1 INTRODUCTION

Submitted papers for reviewing and final version must be written according to the layout and instructions given in this document. Conference language is English. Papers should be submitted electronically as doc, pdf or ps files at the address: iwssip05@teihal.gr

Papers will be send to reviewers in electronic form.

2 LAYOUT AND FORMATTING

The maximum length of the Title is 52 characters. If there are authors from different organisations, please type the organisation and address details in two columns. The paper length is 4 pages, including figures and references. For papers exceeding four pages, an extra charge of 25 EUR for each additional page applies.

Please use 25-mm left, right, top and bottom margins on the A4 (21,0 cm x 29,7 cm) sheet, and 25-mm top, 28-mm left and right, and 7-mm bottom margins on the US-Letter sheet.

The text of the manuscript must be typed in two columns (except title, addresses, abstract and keywords) with single line spacing. Please use Arial font and automatic hyphenation with hyphenation zone of 5 mm. The fond sizes to be used in different parts of the manuscript are given in Table 1.

First paragraph begins without indentation, all other paragraphs with a 5-mm indentation. Do not add blank lines between paragraphs. Leave one line space above all headings. Use three levels of numbered headings at most.

The title of the manuscript, full names, organisations and addresses of the authors should be centred. The title must not exceed two lines. Try to avoid acronyms and abbreviations in the title.

3 FIGURES, TABLES AND EQUATIONS

Figures and tables should be referred to in the text and they should be placed on the same page, where they have been first discussed.

3.1 Figures

Figures must be readable: text strings included should be 10 points minimum. The minimum printable line width is 0,3 mm. Black and white figures are preferred. Colours do not reproduce when printed. The maximum with of a picture in one column is 7,5 cm, and in two column pictures the maximum width is 15 cm.

Figures have to be numbered and must have captions under the figures. Use one empty line between figures, captions and texts. The figures must be included in the data form.

3.2 Tables

Tables must be numbered and have captions above the tables. See table 1 on the first page.

3.3 Equations

Equations should be placed on separate lines and numbered. The numbers should be within brackets and right aligned. See the example (1).

If you continue with explanation of equation, the paragraph followed equation must not be indented.

4 PARTS REQUIRED

The text should start with the title and author(s) information. Please give in any case keywords (max. 3). After the main text there is a list of references. The references should be numbered in the order of their citation in the next and refereed to in the text in square brackets (e.g. books [1], journal articles [2] and conference papers [3]). After the reference list add the address of the corresponding author(s) for further contacts.

Do not type page numbers on the pages.
