Who we are:

With more than 70 scientific staff, the Institute of Telecommunications (TC) is one of the largest in the Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Information Technology at Vienna University of Technology. With the core of the institute founded in 1928, it has a long tradition of excellence in teaching and research. In its history, the institute went through a number of organizational changes, with the most recent one in January 2011, when the former Institute of Communications and Radio-Frequency Engineering (INTHFT) and the former Institute of Broadband Communications (IBK) merged to form the new Institute of Telecommunications (TC).

The institute contributes to teaching in Electrical Engineering and Computer Science through courses covering a wide range of subjects in signals and systems, communications, radio-frequency engineering, and communication networks. The institute's research is in fields of practical relevance, including mobile communications, flexible wireless systems, multimedia systems, optical communications, signal processing, communication theory, radio frequency engineering, and broadband communications. Projects range from fundamental research to hardware design and many of them are carried out in close cooperation with industrial partners and/or in the framework of international projects and programs.

How to reach us from the Airport:


If you take a taxi from the Vienna airport (Flughafen Wien, VIC) it will take about 35 min but it will cost a lot - expect around € 40. There is the possibility of preorders to save costs, e.g. at http://vienna-airporttaxi.at/index.html.

The Airport-City train (CAT) connects to the City Air Terminal Wien Mitte-Landstrasse in just 16min with a fare of \in 9. But you can also go by the Regional Railway System S7 (Schnellbahn). It is cheaper (\in 4) but takes longer (32min). From there you can also go with the underground line U4 to Karlsplatz.

Our department is located in the 4th district at Gusshausstrasse 25. To reach it, take any of the metro lines U1, U2 or U4 to the stop "Karlsplatz", the Vienna metro map:



From Karlsplatz, you can easily walk (about 5 min.) to Gusshausstrasse shown in the following map:



This map shows some of the university buildings; our institute has the building code CG and is the old building next to the modern one located at the corner Gusshausstrasse/ Favoritenstrasse. The conference takes place in the CF building.

When you enter the building from Gusshausstrasse, you will enter the reception area. After that the conference itself takes place in the 2^{nd} floor of the building CF. The secretary's office is at the third floor and the phone number is 58801-38901, just in case you get lost.
